**International Festival and Summer School  
31 July – 14 August 2004**

Welcome to LDSM Festival 2004.

This is a year of excitement and expansion. We go from Ulverston's charming Coronation Hall in the south to the inspiring grandeur of Carlisle's Cathedral in the north and take in Cumbria's time-weathered churches and other familiar LDSM venues on our music-making highway.

Are you under the spell of Early Music? Don't miss the two different programmes given by Red Priest, who use Vivaldi's nickname as their own, as they take us into the 17th and 18th centuries. In addition, Apollo & Pan bring us Renaissance music in Rydal Church.

Move swiftly to the wit and drama of Mozart's *Marriage of Figaro* given in Kendal's Brewery Arts Centre and the story of Dickens's Miss Havesham brought to theatrical heights by Maxwell Davies and sung by the renowned Jane Manning.

Janáček and Mozart are coupled in programmes given by the Chilingirian and Szymanowski Quartets and pianist Leon McCawley. The outstanding animated film of Janáček's opera *The Cunning Little Vixen*, a BBC collaboration with Opera Europe, Kent Nagano and the Berlin Radio Symphony Orchestra with a lecture demonstration on the making of the film, is given in the Brewery's cinema. Radio 3 will record the Janáček concerts for future festival broadcasts.

Steven Osborne, now a leading young pianist on the world circuit, features Liszt in his first programme and jazz and improvisation in a late night concert. The Galliard Ensemble take us into the soundscape of woodwind instruments and the voices of Lancaster Singers join with Manchester's Camerata Ensemble conducted by Denis McCaldin.

Rising Stars, young professionals and all prize-winners, feature in morning and afternoon recitals. The National Youth Orchestra's Sinfonietta, conducted by Andrew Morley (another Rising Star), close the Festival programme with an afternoon workshop and evening concert, completing the Festival journey of a full circle and returning to our starting-point at Ulverston's Coronation Hall.
