is a separate charity which was set up in 1985 at the same time as the Lake District Summer Music Festival. The two charities have been closely associated ever since. Our purpose, shared by the Festival itself, is to encourage the development of young and talented musicians and offer them practical support in their early careers.

We currently do this through our own series of New Generation Artists concerts between January and May. Music education opportunities in schools are being developed alongside these concerts through a partnership with Music Hub Cumbria. This has made it possible for a number of our young musicians to give concerts and workshops in local schools that are also streamed to schools across Cumbria.

We also continue the aims of our charity in 2019 by providing key financial support towards the Festival Debut Concerts along with related Master Classes, where young musicians are tutored by established artists in front of an audience. These events showcase young musicians during the Festival and nurture their talents by providing professional development opportunities.

There are nearly 300 subscribing patrons and benefactors; individuals and couples who feel strongly that young artists deserve as much support as possible in their early careers.
